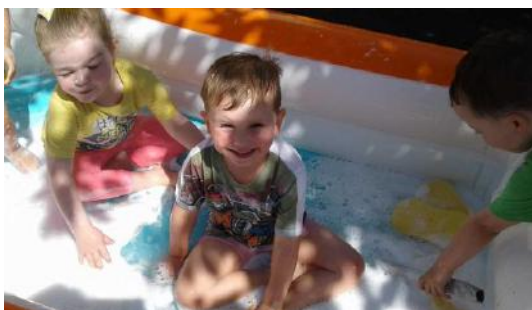

REMINDERS

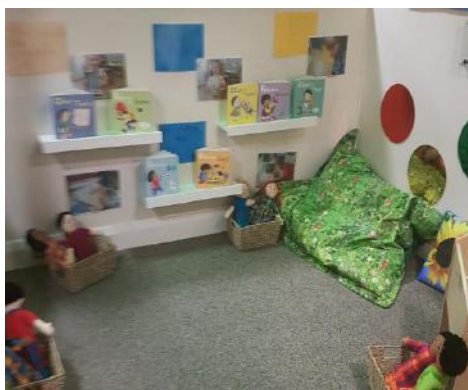

Employee of the month

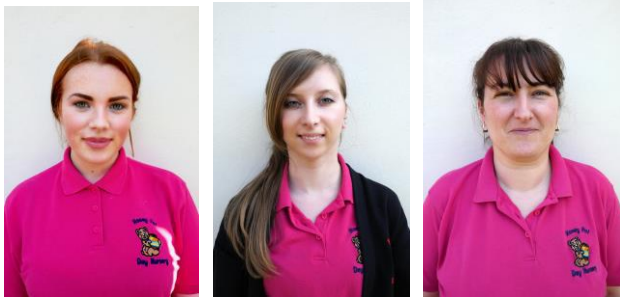
Moe
